their houses, the services they need to recover from Hurricane Harvey.

Harris County Project Recovery-Harvey is for homeowners outside Houston to apply for home repair, reconstruction or reimbursement.

The new Harris County Judge Lina Hidalgo indicated that the county is giving out about \$200 Million in this program, "Harvey was an especially difficult disaster because it got to the core of people's lives because it reached into their homes, in their housing. People's homes

are anchors for them and their families. When peo-ple lost their homes and were forced to leave and live somewhere else, they were still forced to watch and wait until they could rebuild and return. That destroys and disrupts the rest of their lives and the fabric of our community."

"For the first time we are making a massive investment in housing around Harvey," said Hidalgo, indicating that the program was to be the

Arkema faces new charges

CROSBY - According to responders and the com-Harris County District Attorney Kim Ogg a grand jury has indicted Arkema Inc. and Mike Keough, the company's vice president of logistics, on a felony charge of causing bodily injury to two sheriff's deputies by withholding critical information needed by first responders to protect themselves and the community from chemicals released when Arkema's Crosby Plant caught fire after Hurricane Harvey in

Said Ogg on April 10, "The facts show Arkema knew of the dangers, withheld vital information, and unleashed harm on first

munity. This felony indictment is a wake-up call to companies that would pollute our air and waterways, ignore best practices in safety, and put our com-munities at risk."

Rusty Hardin has been retained by Arkema as attorney and answered the charges on the company's website. "Harris County prosecutors are doubling down on an unprecedented and outrageous attempt to criminalize a natural disaster," Hardin said in the statement. "They have filed more charges trying to prosecute a company for

the Act of God that was Hurricane Harvey. We can only conclude that with a May trial date looming, prosecutors realize they can't prove the previous charges and are grasping at straws. This is a politi-cal prosecution in search of a theory. Many citizens, businesses and even Harris County courthouses have still not recovered from the unexpected disaster that Harvey was. Yet the DA's office persists in trying to place criminal blame on Arkema and its employees despite their remarkable and heroic efforts amid the six feet of

water no one predicted.

The Harris County
Flood Control District concluded that in the area of Arkema's Crosby plant, Harvey was a 5,000- to 20,000-year rainfall event. That our county prosecutor persists in desperately seeking a way to criminally blame a company for the ravages of this storm should give us all pause. Arkema stands by its employees and will fight this unwarranted political ac-

The new charges came after an indictment eight months earlier for release of toxic chemicals after Hurricane Harvey, naming Arkema CEO Richard Rowe and plant manager Leslie Comardelle. They were charged with reckless emission of an air contaminant under the Texas Water Code. That trial is to begin May 20.

These criminal charges coincide with lawsuits filed against the company by first responders. Residents were evacuated after Hurricane Harvey for a distance of 1.5 miles.

Senate approves limit on property tax rate hikes

would have less room to raise property taxes before they have to ask voters for approval under a bill passed by the Senate on Monday. Under current law, school districts, cities, counties and other special taxing entities can raise taxes as much as eight percent in a year before voters can petition to hold a tax

ratification or "rollback" election This is too high, says Houston Senator Paul Bettencourt. He said average property tax bills area by 55 percent over the last five years, 43 percent in Harris county over that same time, and it's like that across the state. Bettencourt says that too many people are being priced out of their homes by skyrocketing tax bills. "Taxpayers can't take it any more," he said. "It's a growth curve that's by any measure two or three times faster than their ability to pay." Bettencourt's bill, SB 2, would lower the rollback rate and implement a number of reforms to the process

Under SB2 the rollback rate would fall from 8 to 3.5 percent for counties, cities and most other taxing entities. For local school property taxes, which make up more than half of most tax bills, the rate would decrease to 2.5 percent. Property values from structures built in the last year wouldn't count against the cap, nor would costs related to indigent healthcare and legal defense. Rather than requiring voters to petition for enough signatures to trigger an tax ratification election, the question would be placed on the November ballot automatically if a taxing entity exceeds the rollback rates. These provisions would not immediately apply to taxing jurisdictions with less than \$15 million in annual collections but would require an election in May of 2020 asking voters in those jurisdictions if they want to

This rollback provision has been controversial, but the bill contains a number of widely agreed-upon provisions intended to increase transparency and taxpayer agency in the property

The bill would create an online portal that would provide a wealth of tax information for property owners, who could search their address to see relevant statistics including property value, number and names of entities levying taxes, and rate growth. It would enhance public posting requirements for tax hearings and would establish a dedicated position within each county to ensure that local taxing jurisdictions comply with the online portal and posting requirements. Some statutory definitions would change to make them more clear to taxpayers and voters. What is now known as the effective tax rate, that rate at which the entity would earn the exact same amount of revenue as in the previous year, would be renamed to the "no-new revenue" tax rate. It would also change the term "rollback rate" to "voter-approved rate"

The bill also includes a number of reforms to the appraisal appeal process, whereby homeowners can protest the value of their home pefore an appraisal review board. If a property owner believes that his or her property was overvalued, leading to a higher property tax bill, they can challenge the value. 

Top officeholders join together in push for funding solution

AUSTIN — Gov. Greg Abbott, Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick and House Speak-er Dennis Bonnen on April 10 released a joint state ment promoting a twofold method for the 86th Texas Legislature to curb property tax increases across the state.

"Texans are fed up with skyrocketing property taxes. At the beginning of the legislative session, the governor, lieutenant governor and speaker laid out an agenda for property tax relief through the passage of Senate Bill 2 and House Bill 2 to limit property tax growth," the state's top of-ficeholders said.

 ${\rm SB}~2$ and ${\rm HB}~2,$ the notyet-approved property tax reform bills, would reduce the revenue growth increment used for determina-tion of the rollback tax rate from 8.0 percent to 2.5 percent for taxing units other than small taxing units unless the voters in a small taxing unit election decide to opt-in to the proposed new voter-approved tax rate procedure. The goal of both pieces of legislation is to reduce tax revenues for local taxing units and increase costs to the state through revised formulas

down property tax rates for all Texas homeowners and businesses once Senate Bill 2 or House Bill 2 is agreed to and passed by both chambers," they said in the joint statement. "If the one-cent increase in the sales tax passes, it will result in billions of dollars in revenue to help drive down property taxes in the short and long term."

Senate and House mem bers of both political par-ties have expressed reluctance to cede local control in their districts to tax revenue-generating proposals coming from Austin. Another dimension is that a club-like Senate tradition requires at least three-fifths, or 19, of the body's 31 members to agree to bring a measure to the floor for debate.

Patrick, who presides over the Senate, reportedly last week was entertain-ing the possibility of breaking with precedent by allowing the tax reform proposal to come to the floor with only 16 votes. There could be enough agreement among the body's Republican mem-bers to fall in line with Patrick's wishes

As the possibility of property tax caps and a

sales tax tradeoff simmers in the Senate, passage is harder to predict in the majority-Republican but not-so-collegial House. Dif-ferences in the House and Senate versions of the tax reform bill would have to be reconciled in a conference committee before returning to the full bodies for final approval

Budget bill to conference

Lawmakers' constitu-tionally mandated job is to pass a state budget. As al-ways, it's a messy process to do that.

Two legislators have filed bills in this session to allow the Barbers Hill ISD to be served by a Community College other than Lee College. Representative Steve Toth, R-Woodlands, and Senator Brandon Creighton, R-Conroe have filed House Bill 3835 and Senate Bill 2344. These would allow an existing community college to annex another community college's non-taxing service area, either by election or by contract.
BHISD Superintendent

Greg Poole has indicated the issues are the tax rate, local control, and choice. These have led the district to align their interests with another Community College, in this case Lone Star College, for higher education service for residents and their students.


Officials at Lee College, including President Dennis Brown, were not aware of the pending legislation until it was actually filed in Austin. In Brown's words, "I am incensed,

we are having to address an issue which should not be." Brown went on to say that Lee College was prepared to provide the community, students and residents with whatever they asked for and needed in a community college. He noted that the legislation was filed on the last day that bills could be filed in this session, adding to the surprise action.

College officials plan to fight

the school district's attempt to leave the Lee College service area, they said. This is the third time that BHISD has attempted to leave Lee College's service area and have their own community college, but the approach is different. In the previous two sessions, they sought to change the Education Code's population threshold to allow them to form their own junior college. In this proposal, another community college, Lone Star College, would annex BHISD's service area and provide educational servic-

son for the initiative is to provide community college servictaxpayer" and in addition have a building or physical presence in the community.

The legislation is far reaching, and involves more than the Barbers Hill district. As written, any large community college in the state could extend their service area beyond their current 60 mile limit, and ostensibly seek wealthy districts with large tax bases. Oppo-

nents of the bill say this is what Lone Star College and BHISD are attempting, and long term consequences could destabilize the whole community college system, according to Mark Hall and the Lee College Regents, in a recent public statement. Barbers Hill has a \$10 billion tax base, expected to grow to \$16 billion by 2022. The regents point out that Lone Star College declined to serve Huffman and Crosby when they asked, possibly because of their

In an effort to provide BHISD's desire for their own bulding, Brown met with Poole and explored that possibility, possibly financed by a 5-cent maintenance tax on residents. Poole said they rejected the proposal due to a lack of control over the "governance" of the tax monie

President Brown has asked help from the Texas Association of Community Colleges to oppose the bills. They have had to lobby in Austin against similar bills in the last two legislative sessions, and plan to do the same this time. The deadline for reporting out of committee the bills, for action in this session, is May 6 for the House, and May 18 for the Senate. After that, if not moved to the floor for consideration, the bills will be dead. Dr. Brown at Lee College said that so far he has had good response from other community colleges opposing the legislation, realizing it could affect them in the fu ture, as well as Barbers Hill

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said Election shall be held on May 4, 2019, a uniform election date established by Section 41.001(a), Texas Election Code, as required by Texas law;

WHEREAS, the Board, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, has agreed to enter into a Joint Election Agreement with Harris County, Texas (the "County") and contract with the Harris County Elections Administrator (the "County Elections Administrator") for election services; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CHANNELVIEW INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Findings. (a) The statements contained in the preamble of this Election Order are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

- (b) If the bonds are authorized, the estimated total tax rate of the District is expected to be approximately \$1.5135 per \$100 of taxable assessed value, which represents the sum of (i) the most recently adopted tax rate for operations and maintenance, which is \$1.040 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation, plus (ii) the estimated tax rate for voted debt obligations of the District, including the bonds, which is expected to be approximately \$0.4735 per \$100 of taxable assessed value. This estimated total tax rate is derived from projections obtained from the District's financial advisor and the appraisal district and is provided without any assurance that such projections will be realized. At the time that bonds are issued, the actual total tax rate will depend upon, among other factors, prevailing interest rates, the assessed value of real property in the District, the availability of the Permanent School Fund Guaranty and general market conditions.
 - (c) As of the beginning of the District's current fiscal year,
 - the aggregate amount of outstanding principal of the District's voted debt obligations was \$129,995,000;
 - the aggregate amount of outstanding interest on the District's voted debt obligations was \$56,748,284.30 and
 - the District's ad valorem debt service tax rate as of the date of adoption of this Election Order is \$0.356 per \$100 of taxable property.

The statements contained in these findings (i) are based on information available to the District on the date of adoption of this Election Order, including projections obtained from the District's financial advisor, (ii) necessarily consist of estimates and projections that are subject to change based on facts, circumstances and conditions at the time that bonds approved pursuant to this Election Order are issued and (iii) are not intended to limit the authority of the Board to issue bonds in accordance with other terms contained in this Election Order. Accordingly, actual tax rates, interest rates, maturity dates, aggregate outstanding indebtedness and interest on such debt will vary and will be established after the bonds are issued. To the extent of any conflict between this subsection and other terms of this Election Order, such other terms control.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Date; The Election shall be held for and within the School District on Saturday, May 4, 2019 (the "Election Day"), in accordance with the Texas Election Code (the "Code").

Section 3. Election Precincts, Voting Locations and Voting Hours on Election Day. The election precincts for the Election shall consist of the territory within the boundaries of the District situated within one or more Harris County election precincts, which bear the precinct numbers set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein. The polling places for voting on Election Day shall be as established by the County and set forth in Exhibit A. On Election Day the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 4. Early Voting Locations, Dates and Times. (a) Early voting by personal appearance shall be held at the location, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein or, with respect to the County early voting locations, at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the County Elections Administrator.

(b) Applications for ballot by mail shall be sent to: Diane Trautman, Harris County Clerk, Attn: Elections Division, P.O. Box 1148, Houston, TX 77251-1148

Section 5. Taxes; Proposition. Taxes sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the bonds or any related credit agreements may be imposed. At the Election the following proposition (the "Proposition"), setting forth the purposes, the principal amount and the maximum maturity date for the bonds to be authorized, shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District in accordance with law:

THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS, THE PURCHASE OF NEW SCHOOL BUSES, WHICH BONDS MAY BE ISSUED IN VARIOUS ISSUES OR SERIES, SHALL MATURE SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE NOT MORE THAN 30 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE, AND SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES. NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DISTRICT WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE; AND SHALL THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY AND PLEDGE, AND CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED, ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AND THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED OR AUTHORIZED IN ANTICIPATION OF, IN RELATION TO, OR IN CONNECTION WITH SAID BONDS: SAID BONDS TO BE ISSUED AND SAID TAXES TO BE LEVIED, PLEDGED, ASSESSED, AND COLLECTED UNDER THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS INCLUDING THE TEXAS EDUCATION CODE?

<u>Section 7.</u> <u>Persons Qualified to Vote.</u> All resident, qualified electors of the School District shall be eligible to vote at the Election.

Section 8. <u>Joint Election</u>. The District has agreed to participate in a joint election with the County who is also holding an election on Election Day and has contracted with the County Elections Administrator for election services.

Section 9. Appointment of Election Officers. (a) Prior to the Election Day, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the Election will be appointed by the County Elections Administrator, and the election judges and alternate judges may be changed and the polling places may be combined for some precincts, pursuant to decisions of the County Elections Administrator. The County Elections Administrator shall also be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots cast in such election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station.

- (b) In addition to the Election Officers established by the County with regard to the conduct of the Election at County voting locations, the Board of Trustees shall by written order, to provide for the conduct of early voting services within the District, appoint a presiding election judge and an alternate presiding election judge, each of whom must be a qualified voter of the District. The presiding judge appointed by the Board of Trustees shall appoint at least two, but not more than six, clerks to assist in conducting such election, one of whom shall be the alternate presiding judge and all of whom shall be qualified voters of the District.
- (c) The Board hereby authorizes the President of the Board of Trustees to appoint any such other officials not designated herein or appointed by the County Elections Administrator as are necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in accordance with the Code.

Section 10. Conduct of Election. The Election shall be held in accordance with the Code, except as modified by the Texas Education Code, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 11. Notice of Election. A substantial copy of the Election Order shall serve as proper notice of the Election. Notice of the Election shall be given in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese by: (i) publishing a substantial copy of this Election Order one time, not earlier than the thirtieth day nor later than the tenth day prior to the date set for the Election, in a newspaper published in the District; (ii) posting a copy of this Election Order on the bulletin board used for posting notices of Board of Trustees meetings and in at least two other public places within the boundaries of the District not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the Election; (iii) posting a copy of this Election Order on Election Day and during early voting by personal appearance in a prominent location at each polling place; and (iv) posting this Election, on the District's website during the 21 days before the Election. Notice of the Election shall also be provided to the County Clerk of Harris County, no later than the 60th day before the Election Day.

Section 12. Notice of Meeting. The Board officially finds, determines, recites and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Election Order is adopted was posted on a bulletin board located at a place convenient to the public at the District's administrative offices for at least seventy-two (72) hours preceding the scheduled time of the meeting; that a telephonic or telegraphic notice of such meeting was given to all news media who have consented to pay any and all expenses incurred by the District in connection with providing such notice, both as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended; and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Election Order and the subject matter thereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon.

<u>Section 13.</u> <u>Authority of Superintendent.</u> The Superintendent of the District shall have the authority to take, or cause to be taken, all actions reasonable and necessary to insure that the Election is fairly held and returns properly counted and tabulated for canvass by the Board, which actions are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 14. Authorization to Execute. The President or Vice President of the Board are each authorized individually to execute and the Secretary of the Board is authorized to attest this Election Order on behalf of the Board; and the President and Vice President of the Board are each authorized individually to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

Section 15. Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Election Order, or the application of the same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, neither the remaining portions of this Election Order nor their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall be affected thereby, it being the intent of the District in adopting this Election Order that nor portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, invalidity or unenforceability of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Election Order are declared to be severable for that purpose.

<u>Section 16.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Election Order is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.




