Crosby celebrates mega M.A.G.A.

Trump greeted by thousands of fans

CROSBY – In an area that enjoys a parade, the most attendance to date was to see the presidential motorcade last week come through from Ellington Air Force Base to FM 2100 down Foley Road.

Micki Rush captured the enthusiasm “We are just here to support our American President coming to our little unincorporated area. The visit from President Trump will bring him to the International facility next door.”

One could see M.A.G.A. (Make America Great Again) posters, vehicles,

and displays everywhere and on rare occasions some protesters with different opinions. This reporter counted five in a sea of red, pro-Trump supporters. Veterans lined up before the American Legion and the Crosby Rodeo Fairgrounds was having difficulty keeping their area clear for event participants to enter.

The visit went off with hardly any hitches. The speech was delivered and the pipelines are under construction as this is written. A single incident happened on Foley Road about 1/8 mile from the Interna-

Harvey Recovery Program starts in Barrett Station

BARRETT STATION – The new leadership of Harris County turned out in force to announce Harris County Project Recovery-Harvey Program at the Harris County Barrett Community Center last Saturday.

Lina Hidalgo, Harris County Judge, Adrian Garcia, Precinct 2 Commissioner, Daphne Lemelle, Harris County Community Services Director and a host of county community workers from varied agencies were present to share their expertise enabling residents to get help for

their houses, the services they need to recover from Hurricane Harvey.

Harris County Project Recovery-Harvey is for homeowners outside Houston to apply for home repair, reconstruction or reimbursement.

The new Harris County Judge Lina Hidalgo indicated that the county is giving out about \$200 Million in this program, “Harvey was an especially difficult disaster because it got to the core of people’s lives because it reached into their homes, in their housing. People’s homes

are anchors for them and their families. When people lost their homes and were forced to leave and live somewhere else, they were still forced to watch and wait until they could rebuild and return. That destroys and disrupts the rest of their lives and the fabric of our community.”

“For the first time we are making a massive investment in housing around Harvey,” said Hidalgo, indicating that the program was to be the

Arkema faces new charges

CROSBY – According to Harris County District Attorney Kim Ogg a grand jury has indicted Arkema Inc. and Mike Keough, the company’s vice president of logistics, on a felony charge of causing bodily injury to two sheriff’s deputies by withholding critical information needed by first responders to protect themselves and the community from chemicals released when Arkema’s Crosby Plant caught fire after Hurricane Harvey in 2017.

Said Ogg on April 10, “The facts show Arkema knew of the dangers, withheld vital information, and unleashed harm on first

responders and the community. This felony indictment is a wake-up call to companies that would pollute our air and waterways, ignore best practices in safety, and put our communities at risk.”

Rusty Hardin has been retained by Arkema as attorney and answered the charges on the company’s website. “Harris County prosecutors are doubling down on an unprecedented and outrageous attempt to criminalize a natural disaster,” Hardin said in the statement. “They have filed more charges trying to prosecute a company for

Fire breaks out in garage at George Foreman’s house

HUFFMAN, Texas – The Harris County Fire Marshal’s Office is investigating a fire that broke out at former professional boxer George Foreman’s home last Sunday night in Huffman.

According to officials, the fire began in the garage, reportedly in a golf cart by the back wall. Crews were able to keep it from spreading to the rest of the home.

There were at least 40 vehicles in the garage, where the fire started, but none of them were damaged. There were people inside the house at the time of the fire, but every-

one managed to get out safely. We don’t know if Foreman was home himself or who saw the fire and called 911.

Foreman sent out a tweet after the fire writing, “Don’t worry all is well. Dogs are barking and I don’t mean my feet. Thanks to all the firefighters. Huffman, Houston, New Caney, Atascocita.”

the Act of God that was Hurricane Harvey. We can only conclude that with a May trial date looming, prosecutors realize they can’t prove the previous charges and are grasping at straws. This is a political prosecution in search of a theory. Many citizens, businesses and even Harris County courthouses have still not recovered from the unexpected disaster that Harvey was. Yet the DA’s office persists in trying to place criminal blame on Arkema and its employees despite their remarkable and heroic efforts amid the six feet of water no one predicted.

The Harris County Flood Control District concluded that in the area of Arkema’s Crosby plant, Harvey was a 5,000- to 20,000-year rainfall event. That our county prosecutor persists in desperately seeking a way to criminally blame a company for the ravages of this storm should give us all pause. Arkema stands by its employees and will fight this unwarranted political action.”

The new charges came after an indictment eight months earlier for release of toxic chemicals after Hurricane Harvey, naming Arkema CEO Richard Rowe and plant manager Leslie Comardelle. They were charged with reckless emission of an air contaminant under the Texas Water Code. That trial is to begin May 20.

These criminal charges coincide with lawsuits filed against the company by first responders. Residents were evacuated after Hurricane Harvey for a distance of 1.5 miles.

largest investment a region has made in the area of housing repair.

"It helps us build a stronger community and a more resilient community in all of Harris County," the Judge concluded.

Precinct 2 Commissioner Adrian Garcia asked folks to get in touch with their representatives, "I will ask you to do one thing. Whenever you get hold of your members of Congress or representatives, any one of them, let them know it is unconscionable that in an area like Harris County, where we know Mother Nature so well, she visits us on a regular basis, we are no strangers to flooding. But, we don't have to reinvent the wheel over and over, since the government ought to have a good plan in place."

He encouraged those needing help with housing to get in touch with www.harrisrecovery.org and fill out the application as soon as possible.

"Know that we share your frustration and that we would rather have to get things done sooner rather than later," said Garcia.

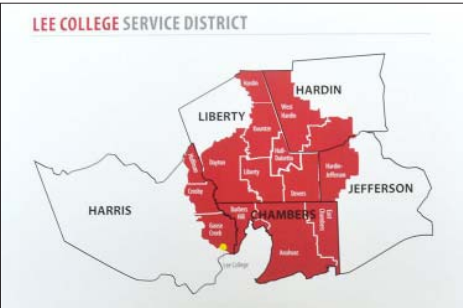
BARBERS HILL AGAIN TRIES TO SECURE ITS OWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Two Legislators, Toth & Creighton, file bills at the last minute

Two legislators have filed bills in this session to allow the Barbers Hill ISD to be served by a Community College other than Lee College. Representative Steve Toth, R-Woodlands, and Senator Brandon Creighton, R-Conroe have filed House Bill 3835 and Senate Bill 2344. These would allow an existing community college to annex another community college's non-taxing service area, either by election or by contract. BHISD Superintendent Greg Poole has indicated the issues are the tax rate, local control, and choice. These have led the district to align their interests with another Community College, in this case Lone Star College, for higher education service for residents and their students. Officials at Lee College, including President Dennis Brown, were not aware of the pending legislation until it was actually filed in Austin. In Brown's words, "I am incensed, and that is a polite word, that

we are having to address an issue which should not be." Brown went on to say that Lee College was prepared to provide the community, students, and residents with whatever they asked for and needed in a community college. He noted that the legislation was filed on the last day that bills could be filed in this session, adding to the surprise action. College officials plan to fight the school district's attempt to leave the Lee College service area, they said. This is the third time that BHISD has attempted to leave Lee College's service area and have their own community college, but the approach is different. In the previous two sessions, they sought to change the Education Code's population threshold to allow them to form their own junior college. In this proposal, another community college, Lone Star College, would annex BHISD's service area and provide educational services. BHISD Superintendent Greg Poole said that the rea-



son for the initiative is to provide community college services "at minimal or no cost to the taxpayer" and in addition have a building or physical presence in the community. The legislation is far reaching, and involves more than the Barbers Hill district. As written, any large community college in the state could extend their service area beyond their current 60 mile limit, and ostensibly seek wealthy districts with large tax bases. Opponents of the bill say this is what Lone Star College and BHISD are attempting, and long term consequences could destabilize the whole community college system, according to Mark Hall and the Lee College Regents, in a recent public statement. Barbers Hill has a \$10 billion tax base, expected to grow to \$16 billion by 2022. The regents point out that Lone Star College declined to serve Huffman and Crosby when they asked, possibly because of their

smaller tax base. In an effort to provide BHISD's desire for their own building, Brown met with Poole and explored that possibility, possibly financed by a 5-cent maintenance tax on residents. Poole said they rejected the proposal due to a lack of control over the "governance" of the tax monies. President Brown has asked help from the Texas Association of Community Colleges to oppose the bills. They have had to lobby in Austin against similar bills in the last two legislative sessions, and plan to do the same this time. The deadline for reporting out of committee the bills, for action in this session, is May 6 for the House, and May 18 for the Senate. After that, if not moved to the floor for consideration, the bills will be dead. Dr. Brown at Lee College said that so far he has had good response from other community colleges opposing the legislation, realizing it could affect them in the future, as well as Barbers Hill and Lee College.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of Channelview Independent School District (the “District”) finds and determines that it is necessary and advisable to call and hold an election (the “Election”) for and within the District on the proposition hereinafter set forth;

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said Election shall be held on May 4, 2019, a uniform election date established by Section 41.001(a), Texas Election Code, as required by Texas law;

WHEREAS, the Board, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, has agreed to enter into a Joint Election Agreement with Harris County, Texas (the “County”) and contract with the Harris County Elections Administrator (the “County Elections Administrator”) for election services; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CHANNELVIEW INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Findings. (a) The statements contained in the preamble of this Election Order are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

(b) If the bonds are authorized, the estimated total tax rate of the District is expected to be approximately \$1.5135 per \$100 of taxable assessed value, which represents the sum of (i) the most recently adopted tax rate for operations and maintenance, which is \$1.040 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation, plus (ii) the estimated tax rate for voted debt obligations of the District, including the bonds, which is expected to be approximately \$0.4735 per \$100 of taxable assessed value. This estimated total tax rate is derived from projections obtained from the District’s financial advisor and the appraisal district and is provided without any assurance that such projections will be realized. At the time that bonds are issued, the actual total tax rate will depend upon, among other factors, prevailing interest rates, the assessed value of real property in the District, the availability of the Permanent School Fund Guaranty and general market conditions.

- (c) As of the beginning of the District’s current fiscal year,
- the aggregate amount of outstanding principal of the District’s voted debt obligations was \$129,995,000;
 - the aggregate amount of outstanding interest on the District’s voted debt obligations was \$56,748,284.30 and
 - the District’s ad valorem debt service tax rate as of the date of adoption of this Election Order is \$0.356 per \$100 of taxable property.

The statements contained in these findings (i) are based on information available to the District on the date of adoption of this Election Order, including projections obtained from the District’s financial advisor, (ii) necessarily consist of estimates and projections that are subject to change based on facts, circumstances and conditions at the time that bonds approved pursuant to this Election Order are issued and (iii) are not intended to limit the authority of the Board to issue bonds in accordance with other terms contained in this Election Order. Accordingly, actual tax rates, interest rates, maturity dates, aggregate outstanding indebtedness and interest on such debt will vary and will be established after the bonds are issued. To the extent of any conflict between this subsection and other terms of this Election Order, such other terms control.

Section 2. Election Ordered; Date; The Election shall be held for and within the School District on Saturday, May 4, 2019 (the “Election Day”), in accordance with the Texas Election Code (the “Code”).

Section 3. Election Precincts, Voting Locations and Voting Hours on Election Day. The election precincts for the Election shall consist of the territory within the boundaries of the District situated within one or more Harris County election precincts, which bear the precinct numbers set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein. The polling places for voting on Election Day shall be as established by the County and set forth in Exhibit A. On Election Day the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 4. Early Voting Locations, Dates and Times. (a) Early voting by personal appearance shall be held at the location, at the times and on the days set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein or, with respect to the County early voting locations, at such other locations as hereafter may be designated by the County Elections Administrator.

(b) Applications for ballot by mail shall be sent to: Diane Trautman, Harris County Clerk, Attn: Elections Division, P.O. Box 1148, Houston, TX 77251-1148

Section 5. Taxes; Proposition. Taxes sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the bonds or any related credit agreements may be imposed. Section 7. Persons Qualified to Vote. All resident, qualified electors of the School District shall be eligible to vote at the Election.

Section 8. Joint Election. The District has agreed to participate in a joint election with the County who is also holding an election on Election Day and has contracted with the County Elections Administrator for election services.

Section 9. Appointment of Election Officers. (a) Prior to the Election Day, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the Election will be appointed by the County Elections Administrator, and the election judges and alternate judges may be changed and the polling places may be combined for some precincts, pursuant to decisions of the County Elections Administrator. The County Elections Administrator shall also be responsible for establishing the central counting station for the ballots cast in such election and appointing the personnel necessary for such station.

(b) In addition to the Election Officers established by the County with regard to the conduct of the Election at County voting locations, the Board of Trustees shall by written order, to provide for the conduct of early voting services within the District, appoint a presiding election judge and an alternate presiding election judge, each of whom must be a qualified voter of the District. The presiding judge appointed by the Board of Trustees shall appoint at least two, but not more than six, clerks to assist in conducting such election, one of whom shall be the alternate presiding judge and all of whom shall be qualified voters of the District.

(c) The Board hereby authorizes the President of the Board of Trustees to appoint any such other officials not designated herein or appointed by the County Elections Administrator as are necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in accordance with the Code.

Section 10. Conduct of Election. The Election shall be held in accordance with the Code, except as modified by the Texas Education Code, and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Code pertaining to bilingual requirements.

Section 11. Notice of Election. A substantial copy of the Election Order shall serve as proper notice of the Election. Notice of the Election shall be given in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese by: (i) publishing a substantial copy of this Election Order one time, not earlier than the thirtieth day nor later than the tenth day prior to the date set for the Election, in a newspaper published in the District; (ii) posting a copy of this Election Order on the bulletin board used for posting notices of Board of Trustees meetings and in at least two other public places within the boundaries of the District not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the Election; (iii) posting a copy of this Election Order on Election Day and during early voting by personal appearance in a prominent location at each polling place; and (iv) posting this Election Order, which includes the contents of the Proposition, and shall serve as notice of the Election, on the District’s website during the 21 days before the Election. Notice of the Election shall also be provided to the County Clerk of Harris County, no later than the 60th day before the Election Day.

Section 12. Notice of Meeting. The Board officially finds, determines, recites and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Election Order is adopted was posted on a bulletin board located at a place convenient to the public at the District’s administrative offices for at least seventy-two (72) hours preceding the scheduled time of the meeting; that a telephonic or telegraphic notice of such meeting was given to all news media who have consented to pay any and all expenses incurred by the District in connection with providing such notice, both as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended; and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Election Order and the subject matter thereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon.

Section 13. Authority of Superintendent. The Superintendent of the District shall have the authority to take, or cause to be taken, all actions reasonable and necessary to insure that the Election is fairly held and returns properly counted and tabulated for canvass by the Board, which actions are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 14. Authorization to Execute. The President or Vice President of the Board are each authorized individually to execute and the Secretary of the Board is authorized to attest this Election Order on behalf of the Board; and the President and Vice President of the Board are each authorized individually to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

Section 15. Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Election Order, or the application of the same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, neither the remaining portions of this Election Order nor their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall be affected thereby, it being the intent of the District in adopting this Election Order that nor portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, invalidity or unenforceability of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Election Order are declared to be severable for that purpose.

Section 16. Effective Date. This Election Order is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

Sección 7. Personas habilitadas para votar. Todos los electores habilitados, residentes del Distrito Escolar serán elegibles para votar en la Elección.

Sección 8. Elección Conjunta. El Distrito acordó participar en una elección conjunta con el Condado, que también celebrará una elección el Día de Elección y contrató al Administrador de Elecciones del Condado para que preste servicios electorales.

Các câu trình bày trong các kết luận này (i) là dựa trên thông tin có sẵn cho Học Khu vào ngày thông qua Lệnh Bầu Cử này, kể cả các dự báo có được từ chuyên gia cố vấn tài chính của Học Khu, (ii) nhất thiết bao gồm các mức ước tính và dự báo có thể thay đổi dựa trên thực tế, hoàn cảnh và điều kiện vào thời điểm phát hành các trái phiếu được phê chuẩn theo Lệnh Bầu Cử này và (iii) không nhằm mục đích giới hạn thẩm quyền của Hội Đồng Quản Trị về phát hành trái phiếu theo các điều khoản khác có trong Lệnh Bầu Cử này. Do đó, các mức thuế, mức lãi suất, ngày đáo hạn, tổng số nợ chưa trả và lãi suất của khoản nợ đó trên thực tế sẽ khác nhau và sẽ được xác định sau khi phát hành trái phiếu. Các phân khu bầu cử cho Cuộc Bầu Cử sẽ bao gồm phần địa giới nằm trong ranh giới Học Khu ở trong một hoặc nhiều phân khu bầu cử của Quận Harris, VỚI số phân khu quy định trong Phụ Lục A kèm theo đây và được đưa vào trong Lệnh này. Các địa điểm phòng phiếu để bỏ phiếu vào Ngày Bầu Cử sẽ như quy định trong Phụ Lục A. Vào Ngày Bầu Cử, các phòng phiếu sẽ mở cửa từ 7 giờ sáng đến 7 giờ tối.

Mục 4. Các Địa Điểm và Ngày Giờ Bỏ Phiếu Sớm. (a) Thủ tục đích thân tới bỏ phiếu sớm sẽ diễn ra tại địa điểm và ngày giờ quy định trong Phụ Lục B kèm theo đây và được đưa vào trong lệnh này, hoặc nếu là các địa điểm bỏ phiếu sớm của Quận, tại các địa điểm khác sau này sẽ được Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận ấn định.

Mục 5. Thuế, Kế Hoạch Đề Nghị. Có thể sẽ áp dụng các khoản thuế ở mức thỏa đáng để trả tiền vốn và lãi suất cho các trái phiếu hoặc bất kỳ thỏa thuận tín dụng nào liên quan. Tại Cuộc Bầu Cử, kế hoạch đề nghị ("Kế Hoạch Đề Nghị") sau đây, quy định các mục đích tổ chức bầu cử, số tiền vốn và ngày đáo hạn tối đa cho các trái phiếu sẽ được biểu quyết phê chuẩn, sẽ được đệ trình cho các cử tri hội đủ điều kiện của Học Khu theo qui định của luật pháp:

Mục 8. Cuộc Bầu Cử Kết Hợp. Học Khu đồng ý tham gia một cuộc bầu cử kết hợp với Quận, là bên cũng sẽ tổ chức một cuộc bầu cử vào Ngày Bầu Cử và đã ký hợp đồng với Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận cho các dịch vụ bầu cử.

Mục 9. Bổ Nhiệm Các Viên Chức Bầu Cử. (a) Trước Ngày Bầu Cử, các trưởng ban điều hành bầu cử, các trưởng ban dự khuyết, các thư ký và nhân sự khác cần thiết để tiến hành Cuộc Bầu Cử sẽ được Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận bổ nhiệm, và các trưởng ban điều hành bầu cử và các trưởng ban điều hành dự khuyết có thể được thay đổi, và các phòng phiếu có thể được kết hợp đối với một số phân khu, tùy theo quyết định của Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận. Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận cũng sẽ chịu trách nhiệm thiết lập trạm kiểm phiếu trung tâm cho các lá phiếu đã bầu trong cuộc bầu cử nói trên và bổ nhiệm nhân sự cần thiết cho trạm kiểm phiếu đó.

(b) Ngoài các Viên Chức Bầu Cử do Quận quy định liên quan đến việc tiến hành Cuộc Bầu Cử tại các địa điểm bỏ phiếu của Quận, theo lệnh bằng văn bản, Hội Đồng Quản Trị sẽ cho tiến hành các dịch vụ bỏ phiếu sớm trong phạm vi Học Khu, bổ nhiệm một trưởng ban điều hành tuyển cử và một trưởng ban điều hành tuyển cử dự khuyết, mỗi người phải là cử tri hội đủ điều kiện của Học Khu. (c) Theo đây, Hội Đồng Quản Trị ủy quyền cho Chủ Tịch Hội Đồng Quản Trị bổ nhiệm các viên chức khác không được chỉ định trong tài liệu này hoặc được Quận Trị Viên phụ trách Bầu Cử của Quận bổ nhiệm nếu cần thiết và thích hợp để tiến hành Cuộc Bầu Cử chiếu theo Bộ Luật.

Mục 10. Tiến Hành Cuộc Bầu Cử. Cuộc Bầu Cử sẽ được tổ chức theo quy định của Bộ Luật, trừ khi được tu chính bởi Bộ Luật Giáo Dục Texas, và Đạo Luật Liên Bang về Quyền Bỏ Phiếu ban hành năm 1965, bản tu chính, cụ thể bao gồm Chương 272 của Bộ Luật liên quan tới các quy định song ngữ.

Mục 11. Thông Báo Bầu Cử. Một bản sao y của Lệnh Bầu Cử này sẽ được coi là thông báo hợp thức về Cuộc Bầu Cử. Cuộc Bầu Cử sẽ được thông báo bằng tiếng Anh, tiếng Tây Ban Nha, tiếng Việt và tiếng Hoa theo hình thức: (i) đăng bản sao y của Lệnh Tuyển Cử này một lần, sớm nhất là ba mươi ngày và trễ nhất là mười ngày trước ngày ấn định cho Cuộc Bầu Cử, trong một tờ báo phát hành trong Học Khu; (ii) niêm yết một bản sao của Lệnh Tuyển Cử này trên tờ bảng tin dùng để niêm yết thông báo hợp của Hội Đồng Quản Trị và ở ít nhất nơi công cộng khác trong phạm vi ranh giới của Học Khu trễ nhất là 21 ngày trước ngày ấn định cho Cuộc Bầu Cử; (iii) niêm yết một bản sao của Lệnh Bầu Cử này vào Ngày Bầu Cử và trong thời gian đích thân đến bỏ phiếu sớm ở một nơi nơi bất tại mỗi địa điểm phòng phiếu; và (iv) đăng Lệnh Bầu Cử này, cùng với thông báo Bầu Cử và nội dung Kế Hoạch Đề Nghị, và sẽ là thông báo về Cuộc Bầu Cử, trên website của Học Khu trong 21 ngày trước Cuộc Bầu Cử đó. Thông báo về

Cuộc Bầu Cử cũng sẽ được cung cấp cho Thư Ký Quận Harris, trễ nhất là 60 ngày trước Ngày Bầu Cử.

Mục 12. Thông Báo Hợp. Ban Giám Đốc chính thức nhận thấy, quyết định và tuyên bố rằng văn bản thông báo về ngày giờ và địa điểm và chủ đề của cuộc họp thông qua Lệnh Bầu Cử này đã được niêm yết trên bảng tin đặt ở địa điểm thuận tiện cho công chúng tại các văn phòng hành chính của Học Khu trong ít nhất bảy mươi hai (72) giờ trước giờ họp dự kiến; cuộc họp nói trên đã được thông báo bằng điện thoại hoặc telex cho tất cả các kênh truyền thông thời sự đồng ý trả bất kỳ và tất cả mọi khoản chi phí Học Khu làm phát sinh liên quan đến việc đưa ra thông báo nói trên, cả hai đều theo quy định của Luật Nhóm Hợp Công Khai, Chương 551, Bộ Luật Chính Quyền Texas, như được tu chính và cuộc họp này luôn được công khai theo qui định của luật pháp, tại đó Lệnh Bầu Cử này và nội dung của lệnh được thảo luận, xem xét và thực thi.

Mục 13. Quyền Hạn Của Giám Đốc Học Khu. Chủ tịch hoặc phó chủ tịch Hội Đồng Quản Trị được ủy quyền thi hành và Thư ký của Hội Đồng Quản Trị được ủy quyền chứng thực Lệnh Bầu Cử này thay mặt cho Hội Đồng Quản Trị; và Chủ Tịch và Phó Chủ Tịch Hội Đồng Quản Trị được ủy quyền thực hiện tất cả các công việc khác cần thiết và hợp pháp liên quan đến việc tổ chức và tiến hành cuộc bầu cử trái phiếu nói trên.

MỤC 15. Hiệu Lực Tách Rời. Nếu bất kỳ điều khoản, mục, tiểu mục, câu, mệnh đề hoặc cụm từ nào của Lệnh Bầu Cử này, hoặc việc áp dụng các phần đó cho bất kỳ người nào hoặc bất kỳ tình huống nào, vì bất kỳ lý do nào bị coi là vi hiến, vô hiệu lực, vô giá trị, hoặc không thể thực thi được, thì các phần còn lại của Lệnh Bầu Cử này cũng như việc áp dụng các phần đó cho những người khác hoặc những tình huống khác sẽ không bị ảnh hưởng, và chủ định của Hội Đồng Quản Trị khi thông qua Lệnh Bầu Cử này là không có phần nào hoặc điều khoản nào hoặc nguyên tắc nào trong văn kiện này sẽ trở nên vô hiệu lực chỉ vì bất kỳ phần nào khác trong Lệnh này bị coi là vi hiến, vô hiệu lực, vô giá trị, hoặc không thể thực thi được, và vì mục đích này, tất cả các điều khoản của Lệnh Bầu Cử này được tuyên bố là có thể tách rời.

Mục 16. Ngày Có Hiệu Lực. Lệnh Bầu Cử này có hiệu lực ngay sau khi thông qua và phê chuẩn.

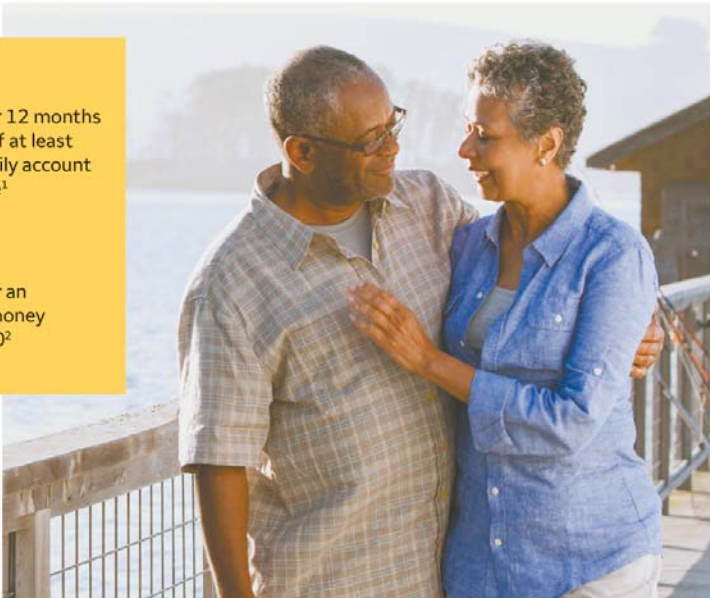
