AUSTIN - State budget writers likely will have more funds to meet the needs of Texas in the
near term, based on information released Oct. 10 by the comptroller's office.
Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar said reve-
nue available for general spending in $2020-21$ is expected to total about 121.76 billion, up 9.6 percent from the 2018-19 would support the $\$ 118.86$ billion in gener-al-purpose spending called for by the 86th Tex result in a final balance available for certification of $\$ 2.89$ billion.
