Judge ends Arkema trial with no convictions

HOUSTON – On October 1, Arkema SA and executives were acquitted of criminal charges related to events that followed Hurricane Harvey in 2017. Arkema executives were charged with the crime of felony assault related to failure to provide adequate emergency response information related to first responders entering into a location with toxic fumes. The company was earlier similarly indicted for failure to assess risks. Although the acquittal bears directly on the responsibility of the company it does not necessarily end the lawsuits related to the incidents. The same judge found



August 25, until September 2, 2017 Hurricane Harvey brought a historic deluge, flooding knocked out power and refrigeration units were lost. Organic peroxides blazed after all cooling methods failed. As warned by company executives at a press briefing at Crosby Volunteer Fire Department Station Two in Newport, trailers containing chemicals that become volatile at normal temperatures explode outside a warehouse at Arkema Chemical Crosby. About 200 locals were evacuated and 21 first responders were treated at local hospitals.

that prosecutors had committed unintentional misconduct. A 2018 US Chemical Safety Board final report indicated that Arkema had not considered flooding a “credible risk” although it is within the flooding plain and that agency urged better preparation for extreme weather. CEO Richard Rowe, Plant Manager Leslie Comardelle were indicted in 2018 and in 2019 Mike Keough, Vice President of Logistics for assault. On September 30, 2020 Judge Belinda Hill dismissed the reckless endangerment charge against Rowe due

Garcia proposes tax cut for Harris County

HARRIS COUNTY – Precinct 2 Commissioner Adrian Garcia proposed this week a motion to cut Harris County property tax rates. The motion was approved by Commissioners Court unanimously. The Garcia plan proposes a rate that will save taxpayers 1.3 cents per \$100 of assessed value on their homes. The plan not only saves taxpayers money, it also still funds crucial priorities such as Flood Control and Harris Health. “This will be our first consecutive tax reduction in at least ten years, and I’m proud to have proposed the motion to put us on a

path toward a rate cut. As we all deal with a pandemic and economic crisis, my hope is that property tax relief will help our neighbors who are struggling. At the same time, essential county services must remain a priority — to both support the local economy, as well as to keep us prepared for any future challenges. Pandemic or not, Harris County remains at risk for devastating flooding, so this proposed tax rate

Work this week will open new IH-10's 3 lanes

TxDOT plans IH-10 at FM 3180 Traffic Configuration Changes from Thursday, October 8th through Monday, October 12th. Motorists are advised to expect delays in this area.

The information below was provided to Chambers County by TxDOT regarding the new IH-10 Main Lane Bridge at FM 3180.

The following activities will take place between October 8 and 12, 2020. Please use caution when travelling this route.

IH-10 Eastbound Main Lane Bridge

1. 9 p.m. Thursday, October 8 through 5 a.m. Friday, October 9: Alternating Eastbound Main Lane Closures

2. Purpose: Switch traffic onto new IH-10 Eastbound Main lane structure with 3 eastbound lanes.

IH-10 Westbound Main Lane Bridge

1. 9 p.m. Friday, October 9 through 5 a.m. Monday, October 12: Alternating Westbound Main Lane Closures

2. Purpose: Placing Westbound Main lane Traffic into its final alignment and opening to three westbound lanes.

Remember, when driving in work zone you are likely to encounter uneven pavement, narrow lanes, concrete barriers, slow-moving heavy equipment and vehicles that make sudden stops. Please keep the following tips from TxDOT in mind:

- Slow down and always follow posted work zone speed limits.

- Pay attention as workers and heavy equipment may only be a few feet from passing vehicles.

- Don't tailgate. Give yourself room to stop in a hurry. Rear-end collisions are the most common kind of work zone crashes.

- Watch out for road crews.

- Allow extra time. Road construction slows things down. Count on it and plan for it.

OCTOBER IS BREAST CANCER MONTH

Get the Facts About Breast Cancer

BAYTOWN — (October 1, 2020) — While many women view breast cancer as a single disease, there are, in fact, many different types of breast cancer. Learning about the many forms of the disease helps in the quest to detect problems early, when chances of a cure are greatest.

"Breast cancer is classified based on where in the breast it arises. The most common place for cancer to start is in the ducts of the breast," said Dr. Esther Dubrovsky, breast surgeon at the Houston Methodist Breast Care Center at Baytown.

With October designated as Breast Cancer Awareness Month, Dubrovsky urges women to learn as much as possible about this common disease.

Fact: Most breast cancers start in the milk ducts. These tubes carry milk from the milk-producing glands (lobules) to the nipple.

Cancers that start in the milk ducts are called ductal carcinomas; cancers that start in the lobules are called lobular carcinoma.

Pinpointing Cancer

"Screening mammograms are catching cancers at very early stages, and it's common to identify cancers that are still confined to the ducts. These cancer cells have not had a chance to break out of the ducts and invade the surrounding breast tissue," Dubrovsky said. "Noninvasive cancer that is confined to the duct is called ductal carcinoma in situ, or DCIS, and is considered stage 0 breast cancer."

Fact: Noninvasive breast cancers rarely cause symptoms or lumps you can feel, but they may appear as tiny areas of calcification (tiny flecks of calcium) on a mammogram.

Invasive Breast Cancers "Breast cancer is classified as invasive if it has grown outside the duct or lobule where it started, into surrounding breast tissue. It then has the potential to spread to other areas of the body," said Dubrovsky.

Fact: About 80 percent of breast cancer is invasive ductal carcinoma (IDC). It appears as a hard, firm lump. In advanced stages of IDC, the skin over the lump may appear dimpled

or the nipple may be retracted (pulled inward).

Fact: About 12 percent of breast cancers are invasive lobular carcinoma (ILC). Rather than appearing as a hard lump, this cancer may feel like a thickening. ILC may be more difficult to detect on a mammogram than IDC.

Early Detection Is Key "You are the first line of defense when it comes to breast cancer. That's why it's crucial to know how your breasts normally look and feel," Dubrovsky said.

Knowing the warning signs will help you recognize when to alert your doctor.

Fact: Mammograms can detect breast cancer in its early stages, up to two

years before a lump can be felt. Early detection means a better chance of a cure.

Fact: According to the American Cancer Society, 90 percent of women with breast cancer are alive five years after diagnosis.

Breast Cancer Symptoms

The following are warning signs of breast cancer. See your doctor if you experience any of these symptoms, but keep in mind that most breast lumps aren't cancer.

- A painless lump or mass in or near the breast
- A change in breast size or firmness
- Breast skin changes, such as dimpling, a sore or a rash
- Nipple itching, burning, rash, turning inward or discharge
- A warm area in the breast
- Pain in the breast
- Swelling under the armpit or of the arm
- Bone pain

Bullock State History Museum Reopens

AUSTIN, TX — The Bullock Texas State History Museum's exhibition galleries and Museum Store will reopen to the public on Saturday, September 12 with key changes to limit the spread of COVID-19, including heightened safety protocols, new open hours, and timed entry.

The Bullock Museum closed on March 17, 2020 in response to the coronavirus pandemic and



immediately began constructing a phased plan to respond to community conditions and ensure the safest possible future reopening. During the closure, the Museum expanded opportunities for online learning through virtual education programming and web resources.

"To meet our educational mission, the Bullock Museum is excited to welcome the public onsite to the Museum once more," said Bullock Museum Director Margaret Koch. "With more than 16,000 years of Texas history on view, we are committed to providing a low-risk learning environment for the community, teachers, and families."

The Museum's phased plan, which began with the reopening of the IMAX® Theatre on September 3 for limited screenings of *Tenet* and two member-only preview days on Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm, will also allow for additional cleaning while closed on Monday and Tuesday of each week.

New safety protocols include timed entry, allowing a limited number of visitors per hour into the Museum's three floors of gallery spaces. Guests are encouraged to reserve their exhibition tickets online prior to their visit. Onsite signage will provide clear information about new policies and encourage social distancing. Masks are required for all staff and visitors ages 10 and older, and sanitization stations will be available throughout the Museum. All public spaces and high-touch areas will be cleaned frequently during the day, and the full building will be disinfected each evening after closing.

Visitors returning to the Bullock Museum will be able to explore the special exhibition *This Light Of Ours: Activist Photographers of the Civil Rights Movement*, a visual story of the struggle against segregation, race-based disenfranchisement, and Jim Crow laws in the 1960s. IMAX documentary screenings will resume during daily open hours and will feature the new family friendly documentary *Into America's Wild*. The IMAX Theatre will also continue screening feature films on select days and times.

"It has been a rough six months for many across Texas, and we understand that not everyone is willing or able to visit the Museum in person at this time. Opening now helps ensure that we'll be here when people feel comfortable visiting again," said Koch. "In the meantime, we'll continue to increase our online learning opportunities designed for all ages, so one never has to feel disconnected from the astounding history of this incredible state."

If community conditions allow, the Museum's Texas Spirit Theater will resume operation later this fall, and the Story of Texas Cafe will reopen in January 2021. The Bullock Museum will continue to offer educational programs and resources online for children, adults and families. For more information, please visit TheStoryofTexas.com.

Early voting starts October 13; "Texas in my rearview mirror"

EARLY VOTING STARTS OCT. 13

Gov. Greg Abbott's executive order and a Texas Supreme Court decision changed some counties' plans for handling mail-in ballots for the Nov. 3 election.

Citing security concerns, Abbott ordered all 254 Texas counties to offer only one drop-off location for absentee ballots.

"These enhanced security protocols will ensure greater transparency and will help stop attempts at illegal voting," Abbott said.

Democrats accused the Republican governor of trying to suppress the vote, particularly in larger metropolitan areas. The League of United Latin American Citizens, the League of Women Voters and two individuals filed a lawsuit to challenge the order.

"Geographically, Harris County is larger than the entire state of Rhode Island," Harris County Judge Lina Hidalgo said. "Our population rivals that of the entire state of Colorado. To propose only a single, secure drop-off location for a county of our size during a pandemic is ludicrous."

Earlier, the Republican-controlled Texas Supreme Court issued a ruling that created a similar partisan reaction about voting security and rights. The court said Harris and other counties could not send unsolicited mail-in ballots to voters.

In-person early voting starts Oct. 13 in Texas. The Texas Library Association is encouraging its member libraries to share election guides created by the League of Women Voters.

Early voting runs until Oct. 30. The deadline to apply for a mail-in ballot is Oct. 23, and the deadline to return a mail-in ballot is Nov. 3.

Along with visiting their local libraries and



reading their local newspapers, people may go to the League's vote411.org for information about their ballots for the general election. Also, the Texas Tribune, a statewide nonprofit news initiative, offers ballot information at TexasTribune.com.

TOP EDUCATORS MAKE THE GRADE

Texas' two top teachers work in opposite ends of the Lone Star state.

The Texas Association of School Administrators honored Eric Hale, a kindergarten and first-grade teacher from the Dallas Independent School District, as the 2021 Elementary Teacher of the Year and Anthony Lopez-Waste, a history teacher from Canutillo ISD in El Paso, as the Secondary Teacher of the Year.

Hale was chosen to represent the state as Texas Teacher of the Year in the National Teacher of the Year competition. The announcement was made during the virtual convention of the school administrators and the Texas Association of School Boards.

"My students and parents have survived a category F-3 tornado and are presently living in a pandemic. It is essential that I make sure they know I am here for them and value their educa-

tional development," said Hale, who teaches at David G. Burnet Elementary School.

Superintendent of the Year honors went to J.A. Gonzalez of McAllen ISD. Hurst-Euleless-Bedford ISD won best school board.

'TEXAS IN MY REARVIEW MIRROR'

Texas lost one of its brightest country stars when singer-songwriter Mac Davis died at age 78 of complications from heart surgery.

Born and raised in Lubbock, Davis was known most for his country/pop songs of the 1970s, including "Baby Don't Get Hooked on Me," and for writing a number of Elvis Presley hits, including "Don't Cry Daddy," "In the Ghetto" and "A Little Less Conversation." Davis also had a successful acting career, starring in his own variety show and the movie "North Dallas Forty."

The address for the West Texas Walk of Fame is 1501 Mac Davis Lane in Lubbock, which he sang about in "Texas in my Rearview Mirror."

"Many hearts are broken today, including my own, with the death of one of my dearest friends, Mac Davis," country legend Dolly Parton tweeted. "We lost one of the world's greatest writers, singers and entertainers."

A date for Davis' funeral is pending. In keeping with the last line of "Rearview Mirror," his wife said he will be buried in Lubbock in his jeans.

"The Stomachache"

I get stomachaches. I get them with regularity and always have.

"It's just gas!" my mother says, and of course, she's right.

My mother tells me I get stomachaches because I have the "Benson stomach," by which she means that I have the same stomach she has, which is the same stomach her mother had, which my grandmother inherited from her mother—who was a Benson.

It seems a little sad that the only time the Benson family comes to mind is when I have a stomachache. Seriously, I know almost nothing about the Bensons except that they were Swedish farmers prone to indigestion. It's not much of a legacy.

Yesterday I had a doozy. It started during my hike. I had eaten nothing recently and eaten nothing different so there was no logical reason to suddenly get a bad stomachache shortly after I started my hike, which typically takes an hour and forty-five minutes.

"It will get better soon," I said as I walked. It did not.

I got to the halfway point in my hike and somehow felt the stomachache should realize that I had hiked for nearly an hour and respond appropriately. It did not.

Whenever I get a stomachache, I remember stomachaches of the past. I distinctly remember my 16th birthday being ruined by a stomachache. I went to a restaurant famous for its spareribs. I haven't eaten spareribs in years, but I can still remember how I was looking forward to those.

My family and I were served our spareribs and I had to leave the restaurant after what seemed like a single bite. I'm pretty sure my family packed up their meal and joined me almost immediately, but I still remember being in the backseat of the car with an awful stomachache on my 16th birthday, overwhelmed by the unfairness of life.

By now, I should know something about stomachaches. I know, once one starts, I must not eat anything. If I eat anything, I will make it much worse and it will last much longer.

In spite of knowing this all my life, I cannot tell you how many times I have sat down to eat, felt a stomachache coming on, and decided "just this once" I can eat a little more (usually really fast) and everything will be fine. Everything is never fine when I do this.

So, now I tell my husband, Peter, "I'm getting a stomachache. If I eat, I will suffer." Somehow, saying it aloud to another person makes me more accountable. If I then go back into the kitchen and fill my plate, I am proving to Peter (and myself) what an idiot I am.

I can go for months without a stomachache. I can persuade myself that stomachaches were something that happened a long time ago and have nothing to do with me anymore. I start to think they will never happen again. It's nice thinking this. It's also not true.

But maybe dwelling on pain isn't the best idea either.

Surely, in my life, I can expect a lot worse than a stomachache to come my way. Intellectually, I know this, and yet I spend almost no time contemplating future pain. Maybe living in denial isn't the worst thing I can do. It isn't fun to anticipate pain and I'm not sure it's useful.

Instead, I try to notice all the days I feel good and I try to be grateful. Yes, there will be more stomachaches because I come from a long line of gassy farmers. But today, I feel fine.

to lack of evidence. Comar-delle was not guilty in a directed verdict. Keough and Arkema had charges dropped last month related to the injuries of first responders.

Arkema hired Rusty Harding to preside over their legal representatives. It was he that began to point out the nature of the historic flood being an “Act of God”

A company statement at that time said, “Our plant employees went to heroic lengths to protect the public, and when flooding overwhelmed their every effort, we proactively notified emergency responders and the public, days before the first fire started,” Arkema stated.

In 2019 Harris County District Attorney Kim Ogg hired additional attorneys to prosecute environmental and safety crimes.

There had been talk of other indictments but charges were dropped related to failure to disclose the presence of certain chemicals when the Harris County Office of Emergency Management indicated they had been given a detailed list of all chemicals present

at the facility.

Suspended last Spring, the trial started up again last month.

“Today’s ruling doesn’t change the fact that dangerous chemicals on Arkema property ignited and were belched in a cloud of toxic smoke over the surrounding communities, and a first responder, there protecting people is now on a lung-transplant list,” said Dane Schiller, speaking for the District Attorney’s Office.

Arkema released a statement on October 1, in part it says, “We’re pleased to see the end of this trial, which should have never taken place at all. The facts of this case did not warrant any indictments, and we do not believe any indictments would have been granted but for the false information presented to the Grand Jury by prosecutors. The prosecutors in this case repeatedly, blatantly and unapologetically broke rules that are in place to protect us all by ensuring our fundamental right to a fair trial.

We are pleased that Judge Belinda Hill found – not once but twice – that the prosecutors had committed misconduct.”

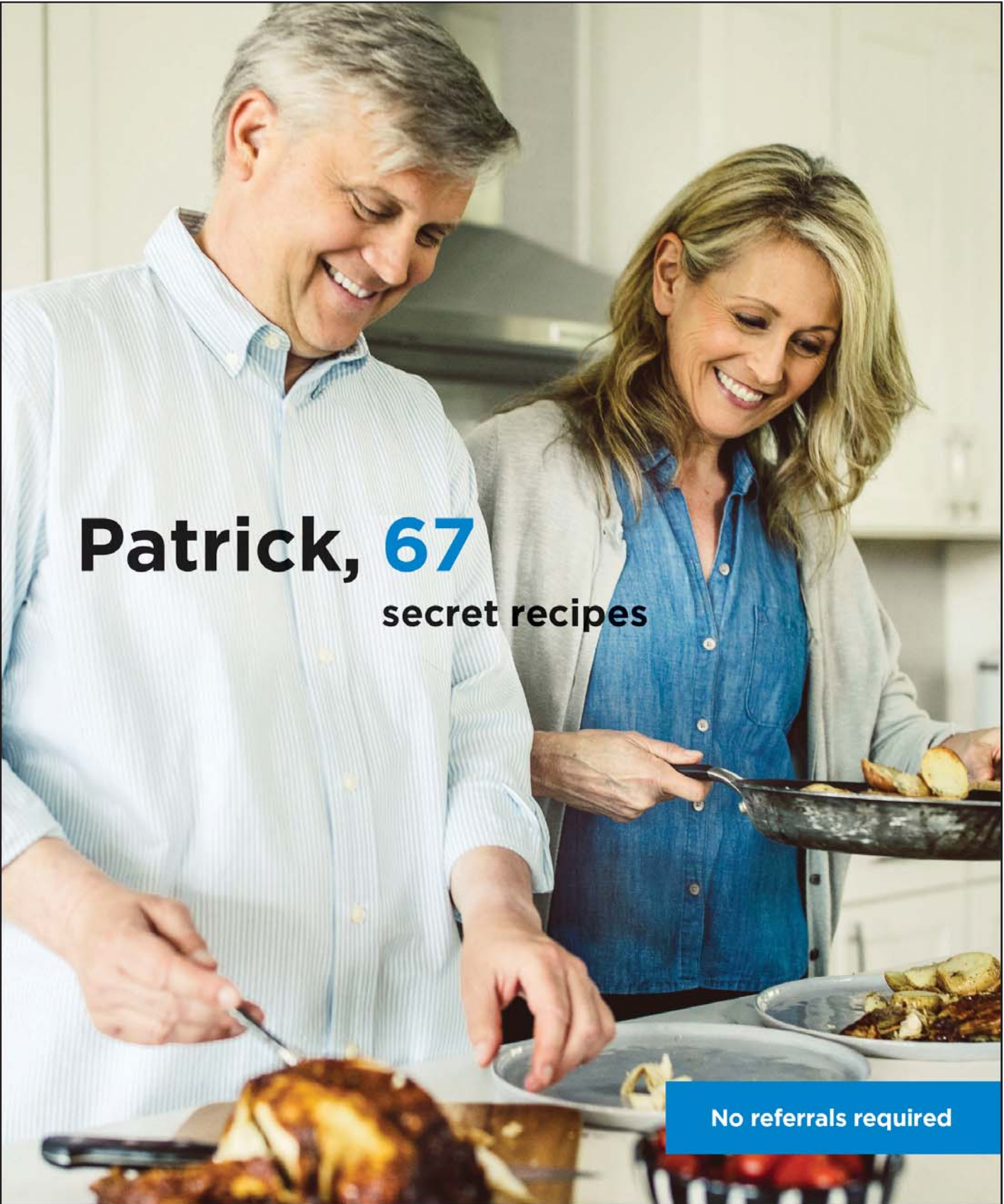

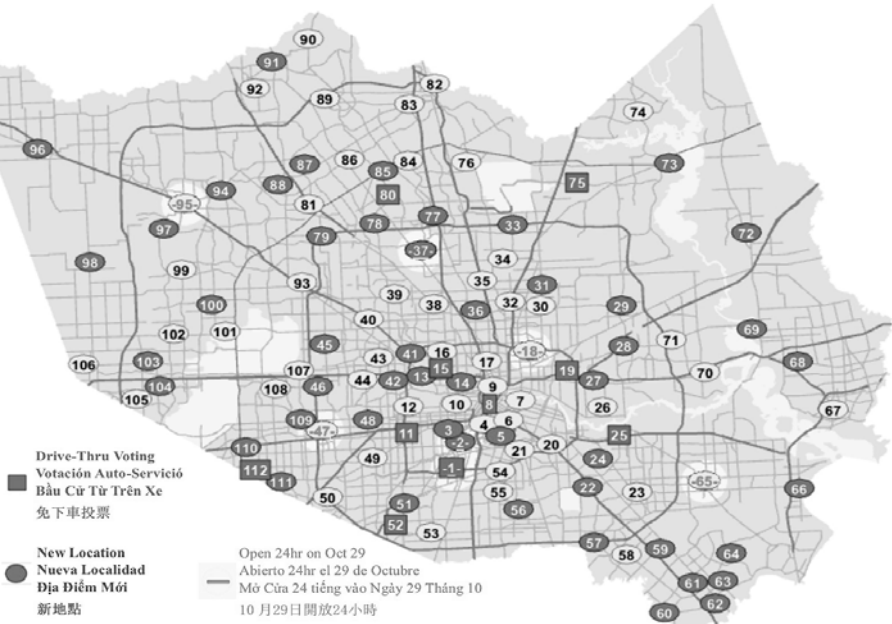
